What is this new logo about?

Exciting news! In July 2019, The Samfund joined forces with Expect Miracles Foundation, a 501(c)(3) public charity that rallies the financial services industry and beyond to invest in life-saving cancer research while advancing the financial and emotional health of people impacted by cancer.

A marquee program of Expect Miracles Foundation, Samfund grants provide support to young adults who are struggling financially because of cancer through direct financial assistance and free online support and education. We're still here, now able to do more and better!



Tell me more about these grants...

Cancer isn't free. The costs go far beyond just the doctors' bills:

- Depleted savings accounts
- Time away from work
- COBRA/Insurance premiums
- Prescription copays

Purpose of the grants:

- Relief from immediate financial pressures so that survivors can instead spend time/energy/money on moving forward towards their goals
- Help survivors feel motivated, supported and empowered

How much is awarded?

The short answer: it depends!

- 2016: \$210,000/138 grants
- 2017: \$117,248/92 grants
- 2018: \$206,615/139 grants
- 2019: \$276,234/171 grants
- 2020: \$452,173/333 grants

Average grant size= \$1,500-\$2,000

Who is eligible to apply? *(updates from last grant cycle)*

- Residents of the U.S.
- Individuals who are 21-39 years old at the time the application is submitted (by August 5, 2021)
- Individuals who are not listed as a dependent on someone else's taxes
- Individuals who meet **ONE** of the following criteria:
 - Completed planned treatment with no evidence of disease, **or**
 - One year following the completion of planned therapy with stable disease, **or**
 - In remission **and** on long-term hormonal therapy (such as Tamoxifen for breast cancer survivors) or long-term targeted therapy (such as Gleevec or Herceptin)
- *Please note: individuals who received a grant in Spring of 2021 must wait until the next grant cycle (Spring 2022) to reapply.*

What types of Samfund grants are awarded? (*expanded since last grant cycle*)

For Family Building (IVF, IUI, Gestational Carrier, Adoption, Embryo Transfer, etc.) requests, please wait until our separate Family Building Grant Application later this Fall!

The Samfund does not provide assistance for:

- *Business-related requests*
- *Undergraduate tuition requests*
- *Credit card repayment requests*
- *Payments or repayment to friends/family members*
- *Purchase of a car*
- *Weddings or vacations*

What do you look for in an applicant?

Good candidates for a grant:

- Can articulate how their cancer experience has impacted their current financial situation (in short essays)
- Have immediate financial needs
- Are not able to get financial assistance from any other source
- Are struggling financially as a result of their treatment (e.g., lost wages in the household, high medical bills, etc.) or treatment aftermath (limited ability to work, side effects, etc.)
- Don't need to be great writers... but do need to be able to answer the questions thoroughly!

What do I need to apply?

- Basic personal and contact information
- Information about your cancer diagnosis and treatment
- Your current financial picture, including monthly expenses and income, assets and liabilities (debts)
- Completion of a Medical History Verification Form, signed by a clinician
- Recent Form 1040s (tax forms) or the completion of an Affidavit (if you have not paid taxes in both of the last two years)
- Name and address of person or company to whom the grant would be paid (payee)

How do I set up an online application?

- Click on the link to the application on or after July 8th at <http://www.thesamfund.org/get-help/grants/>
- Register for an account, or click “change password” if you have previously applied for a grant during another cycle
- Read carefully and follow the instructions for each step
- Answer every question to the best of your ability and as completely as possible
- Make sure you receive an email confirmation when you click “send” to submit your application– if not, contact our office immediately.

Medical History Verification Form

- Download the form from within the application (on our [website](#) NOW), fill in your name and contact info, and send it to your doctor (either a digital or printed copy). You can do this before the application is available!
- The doctor will then need to fill out the other fields on the form, select the appropriate eligibility criteria, and sign it. The completed and signed form should then be returned to YOU. If you need our help uploading your form, email us at grants@thesamfund.org
- This form is required before your application can be submitted, so download it and get it to your doctor right away.

Tax Returns/Affidavit

- You will be asked to submit the FIRST TWO PAGES of 1040s from the last two years you filed taxes or an [IRS tax transcript](#)
- If you did not file taxes in both those years, you will be asked to download and submit an Affidavit– a form stating why you did not file taxes in one or both years– which must be signed by at least one witness



- **Deadline: Thursday, August 5th at 5pm EST.**
- Suggestion: get that Medical History form to your doctor ASAP! No late forms accepted!
- All applicants notified about the status of their application by mid-September 2021.
